To a Hybrid Presentation of Anatomy and Physiology II

(Accelerated 12 Week, Summer, Hybrid presentation)

Hello Student!

Welcome to Anatomy and Physiology II! This course is the second part of a two-part series designed to give the student competency in the structure and function of the human body that will facilitate your ongoing education and training in a career in the allied health professions. To start, this course is presented in a hybrid modality, and involves two components:

- Asynchronous online component (where you work independently). Here you will be engaged with mastery of course content using online guides, videos, outlines, and handouts.
- Synchronous in-class component (where assessment, laboratory exercises, and some instruction occur).

Further, this course is accelerated. Specifically, we will cover roughly 16 weeks of material in about 12 weeks! Therefore, it will be vital for each student to adjust their schedule to have adequate time for mastery of the material. Consequently, it is suggested you allocate two blocks of time toward mastering the material.

- The first is approximately three hours per module to become keenly acquainted with the course content by attending class and viewing course resources and videos.
- The second is approximately three-four hours daily toward the mastering of the course content.

As every student is different, and each one of us has different learning requirements, an effort will need to be made at the outset to assess your individual learning needs. You will want to set aside several hours daily to master the material.
